Whether or not we're there...

"KPC has ongoing commitments every week that need our offering. KPC Program and Missions work is important to us, and so is our financial commitment to this work. That's why we use the PAR plan to fulfill our commitment."

If you pay your bills by direct deposit, then you are familiar with the convenience and reliability of direct deposit programs. The PAR principle means regular contributions throughout the year.

Many people at KPC use the PAR system for their church offering, finding it a convenient way to take care of their regular commitments to the church. You can select monthly or twice monthly giving, whichever works best for your finances.

Your bank account will be debited for the amount you choose and our congregation's bank account will be credited with the amount payable from all members who participate.

Should you wish to change your contribution simply notify the church office two weeks prior to the required date and you will be placed in contact with the church treasurer. Changes received two weeks prior to the next PAR period will be implemented on the next withdrawal.

The KPC PAR program is administered by our Finance Committee on behalf of Session. All giving is held in the strictest confidence.



Advantages to You, the Contributor:

- Regular support of the church in the amount that you choose
- Continual support of the church when you are away
- Avoidance of difficult "catch-up" periods
- Easier and more predictable financial planning
- Reduced bank transactions and fees

Advantages to the Congregation:

- Regular, dependable flow of contributions that enable better planning of program and missions commitments
- Reduction of volunteer hours required to administer offering plate giving and bookkeeping

Three Easy Steps to Participate:

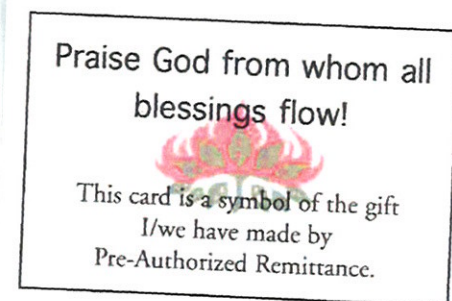
1. Decide the amount of your monthly or twice monthly offering. If you usually give a certain amount weekly, remember there are 4.4 weeks in a month, not four weeks in a month
 - Record what you give weekly and multiply by 4.4 for a monthly amount
 - Record what you give weekly and multiply by 2.2 for a twice monthly amount
2. Complete the PAR Authorization Card and attached a sample cheque from your bank account marked "VOID"
3. Enclose both in an envelope and place in an offering box or hand into the church office
