Good Friday	Jesus is alive!	Good Friday Mark 15-16; Luke 22-24; Matthew 26-28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will be reminded that the real meaning of Easter is to remember the death of Jesus on the cross, and be excited and thankful that he didn't stay dead. Though it is Good Friday, the Big Idea is important to be highlighted: Jesus is alive!
Week One (Easter)	Jesus is alive!	Easter Sunday Mark 15-16; Luke 22-24; Matthew 26-28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will be reminded that the real meaning of Easter is to remember the death of Jesus on the cross, and be excited and thankful that he didn't stay dead.
Week Two	Jesus is alive!	Jesus and Thomas John 20:19-31	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will learn about Jesus' disciple, Thomas, and how he wanted to see Jesus to believe and know Jesus is alive.

Week Three	Jesus is alive!	Fish for Breakfast John 21:1-14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will take time for breakfast with Jesus as they learn the story of Jesus and the disciples who went fishing.
Week Four	Jesus is alive!	Do You Love Me? Mark 3:31-35	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will learn about Peter's nervous encounter with Jesus after Peter had said he wasn't friends with Jesus (three times) and how Jesus made everything okay for Peter. Children will also learn that Jesus is forgiving, and that Jesus gave Peter a special job to do.
